WHO IS ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS FREE PROGRAM?

- No baseball experience necessary *however*, a baseball glove will be needed by all players
- **Space is limited** to 180 total youth (60 players in each co-ed division)
- A waiting list will be created once this program is full

- **Players & parents MUST commit to all practices and games.** Any child that is absent from two practices or games will forfeit their spot and be removed from the program. Players from the waiting list will then be placed on a team.
